Copper and molybdenum mineralization occur in Lower Jurassic Bonanza volcanics.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the Jeune Landing road near the Keogh River, 9 miles due west of Port McNeill.

In 1969 Cominco Ltd. held the Tie 2 to 6, 13, 14, Susan 1 to 16, Ian 1 to 12, and GGB 1 to 32 claims. Work done included geological, magnetometer, induced polarization, and geochemical surveys. Two holes, totalling 648 feet, were diamond drilled.

Associated minerals or products of value - Molybdenum.
