DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Triassic Karmutsen volcanics. Quartz-filled shears occur in andesitic volcanic rocks with minor disseminated pyrite, pyrrhotite, chalcopyrite, bornite and chalcocite. Molybdenite-bearing float also occurs in the vicinity.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between 600 and 900 feet elevation 6 miles southwest of Port McNeill and 12 miles east of O'Connor Lake near the Keogh River.

The Walt 1 to 8, Lon 1 to 9 and Cub 1 to 4 claim groups were owned by J.L. Walton. The property was held by Cominco Ltd. during the period 1968-1970.

In 1968 detailed geological mapping was done and three trenches totalling 1,000 feet in length were bulldozed.

In 1970 the property consisted of the Walt 1 to 9. Walt 1 Fraction, Lon 1 to 4, 7 to 12, Keo 3 to 8, Serp 1 to 9, Triple T, Kink 1, 2, Cougar, Marge L, Reynolds, and Last Chance claims. Work done included magnetometer and geochemical surveys. Two holes were diamond drilled totalling 635 feet on the Reynolds claim.
