DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Minor chalcopryite occurs in fractures and veinlets in hornblende andesite of possible Lower Jurassic Bonanza Formation. Hole M-3 collared in Quatsino limestone, then intersected Karmutsen basalt. Hole M-4 intersected argillite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located north of Rupert Inlet, 2 miles northeast of the Island Copper mine. (See 92 L/11, CU 1).

In 1974, Utah Mines Ltd. held approximately 60 claims including Bim, Bee, Spam, Ken, F, Car and Expo. Surface diamond drilling of four BQ holes totalling 2,220 feet was done on Ken 6, 13 and F 2, 6.
