DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Jurassic Bonanza volcanics. Copper and molybdenum mineralization occur in these rocks. HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The west end of the Koerner block of claims is located one mile east of the southeast end of Rupert Inlet and extends 13 miles to the east to Port McNeill. The Sauce group of 18 claims lies two miles northeast of the east end of Rupert Inlet near Washlawlis Creek.

The Koerner claim block, consisting of 43 square miles of Crown grants, was owned by I. Shulman in 1968. Newmont Mining Corporation of Canada Limited carried out geological, geochemical, magnetometer and induced polarization surveys on parts of the area in 1968 and 1969. One hole was diamond drilled to a depth of 780 feet two miles northeast of the east end of Rupert Inlet.

In 1972 Quintana Minerals Corporation held certain mineral and surface rights to the Koerner tract. The Company rotary drilled two holes totalling 1,000 feet on the property.
