DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Triassic Karmutsen volcanics and Quatsino limestone.

Bornite and chalcopyrite are disseminated in amygdaloidal basalts.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showing is located on Marble River, four miles south of Rupert Inlet at an elevation of 200 feet.

In 1930 the Spooner Bros. owned the Lucky Jim, Winner, Royal, Old Dog, Hard Tack, and Marble Creek claims. A little trenching was done at that time.

Gordon Milbourne held the Kar group of 64 claims in 1967. Seven pits were dug totalling 2,400 cubic feet in 1967 and 3 holes totalling 692 feet were diamond drilled in 1968.
