DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Jurassic Bonanza volcanics. Pyroclastics and flows are intensely sheared and fractured at 010° to 045° near a granitic stock. The rocks are silicified and mineralized with magnetite, pyrite and minor chalcopyrite.
