Work done included a geological survey of 32 line-miles and a geochemical soil survey (800 samples) on the KW 57 to 89 claims. Work done in 1970 included topographical and geological mapping. A geochemical soil survey was carried out over the H and KW claims totalling 747 and 1,238 samples, respectively.

In 1971, geochemical soil sampling and geological mapping were done on KW 11-16, 39-45, 48, 50, 52, 54, and 56, and H 11-32.
