Stringers of chalcopyrite and pyrite occur in andesites of the Bonanza Subgroup.

A channel sample across 4¼ feet gave assay values of 3.8% copper, 1.1 ounce per ton silver, and 0.01 ounce per ton gold.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showing is located ½ mile south of Bay Lake at 300 feet elevation.

The Bay No. 21 claim was part of the Bay group of claims staked in 1965 by Gordon Melbourne. Utah Construction & Mining Co. optioned the property in 1966. The Company dug 2 trenches and several pits. (See 92 L/11, CU 1).
