HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located along the British Columbia Forest Service Nahwitti Lake access road 5 miles west-southwest of Port Hardy and 2 miles east of Kains Lake.

In 1968, the Ram 1-51 claims were owned by Adam Derry and Richard Thomas. Kennco Explorations, (Western) Limited carried out geological mapping and silt and soil geochemical surveys on the claims.

OWNER OR OPERATOR AND ADDRESS

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Upper Triassic Karmutsen volcanics with Upper Triassic Quatsino limestone at the south end of the claim group.

Chalcopyrite, along with pyrite and occasionally bornite, occurs as sparse local disseminations, in isolated quartz-epidote veinlets and in a few amygdules in the volcanics.
