DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Triassic Karmutsen volcanics.

Mineralization consists of chalcopyrite and pyrite in quartz fracture fillings in epidotized volcanic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showing is located on Dick Booth Creek, 2½ miles southwest of Port Hardy, between elevations of 500 and 900 feet.

Utah Construction & Mining Co. Ltd. held the Deb group of 115 claims in 1968. Work done in 1968 and 1969 included a geochemical soil survey and 18 holes diamond drilled totalling 2,322 feet.
