DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The east half of the claim block is underlain from north to south by a succession of Karmutsen volcanic flows and tuffs, Quatsino limestone, and thin-bedded calcareous shale and massive tuffs of the lower Bonanza Subgroup. To the south this succession is in fault contact with Karmutsen Formation. The west half of the claim block is largely underlain by Karmutsen Formation.

Gold, silver, lead, zinc, copper and iron mineralization is reported in skarn within marble associated with intrusive andesitic-gabbroic dykes.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between 800 and 1,000 feet elevation south of Kains Lake and near Nahwitti River 2 miles southwest of Kains Lake.

In 1968 the Mor 1 to 38, Add 1 to 5, and Wob 1 to 58 claims were owned by Frank Onuchi and Don Bragg. A geological and geochemical investigation was done at that time.

The Swiss Aluminium Mining Co. of Canada Ltd. acquired the claims in 1970. Work done in 1970 and 1971 included trenching, mapping of surface workings, topography, and geology, and geochemical and induced polarization surveys.

Associated minerals or products of value - Gold, silver, lead, zinc, iron.
