DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Upper Triassic Karmutsen volcanics and Quatsino limestone.

Copper mineralization occurs in the volcanics as well as in skarn.

A zinc skarn occurs on the Haw 24 claim.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between Kains and Nahwitti Lake, at elevations of 1,000 to 1,500 feet.

In January 1968 Continental Cinch Mines Ltd. acquired the Haw 1 to 27, 29, 31, and 41, and Wit 1 to 22 claims from R.H.D. Philp.

In 1970 the Company carried out geological, geochemical and magnetometer surveys on the Haw, Wit, Cia, Vin, and Plug claims, totalling 79 claims.

Continental Cinch Mines Ltd. changed its name to Gladiator Resources Limited in 1973.
