## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is underlain by quartz diorite and a few northeasterly striking feldspar porphyry and andesite dykes. Three veins are located in the quartz diorite.

The main vein strikes north 84 degrees west for 200 feet and dips 80 degrees southward, is 1- to 3-inches wide and follows a well-defined shear 1 to 10 inches wide. The vein consists of quartz with streaks of sulphides which include principally pyrite and arsenopyrite with smaller amounts of sphalerite and galena. Samples of the vein assayed from 0.1 to 9 ounces of gold per ton.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located east of Goldvalley Creek about 1¼ mile southeast of Zeballos River between 2,300 and 2,500 feet elevation.

The property consists of the Crown granted claims Rimy No. 3, Rimy No. 8, Rimy No. 5, Rimy No. 7, Rimy No. 2, Rimy No. 6 and Rimy No. 1 (Lots 1765 to 1769, 1901 and 1902), staked between 1934 and 1935 by R.A. Pitre, W.J. Pitre and Charles Henri. The claims were Crown granted in 1942.

In 1938 Man-O-War Mines Limited acquired the property and drove two adits on the main vein and one adit on a second vein for a total of 400 feet. Work was completed in 1939.

## HISTORY OF PRODUCTION

In 1938, 19 tons of ore were shipped of which 44 ounces of gold and 51 ounces of silver were recovered.
