The Nootka showings are located at approximately 1,400' elevation on the northeast side of Nomash River 9 km northeast of Zeballos.

The Nootka claim was staked and prospected by Alfred Bird and associates in the early 1930's.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Quartz veining in and adjacent to a shear zone in Upper Triassic Karmutsen volcanics is locally mineralized with pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite. A specimen of slightly oxidized material from the richest part of the vein assayed: copper, 17.07%; gold, 0.40 oz/ton; silver, 3.64 oz/ton.
