DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Andesite, basalt, tuff, breccia, and limestone of the Upper Triassic-Jurassic Bonanza Subgroup are intruded by granite rocks. Some of the contacts show epidote, chlorite, and K-feldspar alteration.

Faulting is extensive. Small veins contain pyrite, pyrrothite, chalcopyrite, sphalerite, and galena.

Associated minerals or products of value - Lead, zinc.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between 1,000 and 2,000 feet elevation at the confluence of Rowland Creek and Kaouk River, 5½ miles east of Fair Harbour, Kyuquot Sound.

In 1972 the Tony 1 to 38, and Ka 1 to 48 claims were owned by Noranda Exploration Company, Limited. Surface geological mapping, 1 inch equals 1,000 feet, was carried out over Tony 1-10, 24-28, 30-32 and Ka 25-28. A geochemical soil survey of 283 samples was carried out over Tony 1-5, 7, 9, 23-25, 30.
