## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The showings consist of two well-defined shears in Bonanza volcanics of Lower Jurassic age. The shears are about 90 feet apart, striking east with steep dips. The shears are mineralized across a width of 2 to 16 inches with pyrite, chalcopyrite, pyrrhotite, and minor sphalerite. Values in gold are reported.

Associated minerals or products of value - **Copper, zinc.**

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of 2,000 feet  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles north of Artlish River and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles east of Tahsish Inlet, Kyuquot Sound.

In 1946 the Scrutor Gold group of 10 recorded claims was owned by A.W. and J. Young. Development consisted of open cuts, and 2 short adits 90 feet and 20 feet in length.
