DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain chiefly by sedimentary and volcanic rocks of the Bonanza Subgroup of Lower Jurassic age. Mineralization is associated with quartz veining in both volcanic and sedimentary rocks. It also occurs as minor disseminations and veinlets of chalcopyrite.

On the B.P. claims is a showing of chalcopyrite, hematite, and magnetite in a shear zone in dark, calcareous, sedimentary rock.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of 1,000 feet at the head of the Malksope River.

The B.P. 1 and 2 claims were part of the Easy property held by Falconbridge Nickel Mines Limited in 1971. Reconnaissance silt sampling and detailed soil sampling were carried out over the 54 claim property in 1970. A total of 1,700 silt and 220 soil samples were collected for analysis.
