HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located two miles northeast of Kyuquot, at the north end of McKay Cove.

In 1973 the Tiny 1 to 8 claims were held by Pechiney Development Limited and The Dorva Mining Co., Ltd. Work done consisted of surface geological mapping, 7 line-miles of magnetometer survey, a geochemical soil survey (150 samples), and 1,200 cubic feet of trenching on Tiny 6 claim.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is underlain by massive and pyroclastic andesites of the Bonanza Subgroup of Lower Jurassic age. Chalcopyrite, bornite, chalcocite, and azurite occur in a shear zone.
