A feldspar porphyry dike intrudes a small diorite and granodiorite stock which intrudes Lower Jurassic Bonanza andesite flows and pyroclastic rocks.

Chalcopyrite and bornite occurs in fractures in the dyke. Chalcopyrite and pyrite are finely disseminated through porphyry, granodiorite, and a hornfels contact zone of the andesite. Molybdenite-bearing quartz veinlets are widely spaced through the diorite.
