HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the east side of a small unnamed lake, 5 miles from the point where Kwois Creek drains into Tahsish Inlet, between 3,000 and 3,700 feet elevation.

In 1974 the KUQ 1 to 10 claims were held by Texada Mines Ltd. The Company and Kaiser Exploration and Mining Company carried out surface geological mapping on the claims. Kaiser dropped its interest in Feb. 1975.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A limestone bed striking northwest and dipping 30 degrees west is in contact with a Jurassic quartz diorite intrusion. Lower Jurassic Bonanza volcanics lie to the east of the intrusion. The limestone is altered to garnet skarn.

Minor disseminated chalcopyrite is associated over a 2,000-foot strike length with flat faults and fractures.
