DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Upper Triassic limestones and Lower Jurassic Bonanza volcanics.

The copper occurs in a skarn zone.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of about 2,500 feet on the north slope of Comstock Mountain along the south side of Bucholz Inlet between Kultus and Smith Coves.

In 1970 Celtic Minerals Ltd. acquired the R group (R 1 to 14, 17 to 30, and 33 to 48 claims) by agreement with Rap Holdings Ltd. Geological mapping and a geochemical survey covering 9 line-miles were carried out on the R claims in 1970 and 1971. The Company subsequently staked the SU 1 to 6 and 11 to 16 claims.

In 1972 the Company carried out geological, geophysical and geochemical surveys plus trenching.

In 1973 the R-SU 1 to 8 claims were added to the 56 claims already held by the company.
