DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by Upper Triassic sediments of the Parson Bay Formation and Lower Jurassic Bonanza volcanics.

Mineralization of pyrrhotite and pyrite occurs in an epidote-garnet skarn adjacent to andesite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at an elevation of 2,275 feet one mile west of Neroutsos Inlet. It adjoins the Superior claim of the Yreka Group (see 92 L/5, CU 1).

In 1903 Edison Mining Company, of Tacoma, Washington, owned the Edison claim. An 80-foot adit was driven by the Company in 1904.

In 1905 the Edison claim was sold to B.J. Murphy and J.D. Murphy and the following year it was Crown-granted (Lot 244).

Iso Explorations Ltd. held an option on the property during 1971 and 1972 and carried out surface geological mapping, electromagnetic, self-potential, magnetometer, and geochemical soil surveys, hand trenching and diamond drilling.
