DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite occurs as low-grade disseminations and in skarn within rocks of the Bonanza subgroup of Lower Jurassic age.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between 1,000 and 3,000 feet elevation, on the southeast slope of Mount Kolzebue, 1 mile north of Klaskino Inlet.

In 1970 the property was acquired by American Smelting and Refining Company and consisted of the Jarr 11 to 32, 50 to 61, 121, and 122 claims. A geochemical stream sediment and soil survey was done which included collecting 200 samples on Jarr 11 to 32 claims. In 1971 the work done included, surface geological mapping covering Jarr 15-20, 121 and 122 claims, a geochemical survey of 35 line-miles covering all claims, a magnetic survey covering Jarr 18-20 claims, and surface diamond drilling of 6 holes totalling 700 feet on Jarr 18, 20, and 54 claims.
