DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Mineralization consists of disseminated chalcopyrite and bornite in andesite and basalt of the Upper Triassic Karmutsen Formation.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations between 600 and 1,500 feet about 2 miles east of Alice Lake, on the west side of Twin Peaks.

In 1968 the Blue group of 48 recorded claims was owned by Alpha Mines Ltd. Geochemical and induced polarization surveys were carried out on the claims.
