DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area is underlain by north-south trending Triassic limestone of the Quatsino and Parson Bay Formation. Triassic volcanics of Karmutsen Formation lies to the east and Jurassic volcanics of the Bonanza Group lies to the west. Copper mineralization occurs on the contact of the volcanics and limestones.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The showings are located on the east slope of Mt. Hoy at the northeast end of Bonanza Lake.

In 1972 an evaluation and exploration program was done for First National Uranium Mines Ltd. The Bon Group of 8 claims was held 50-50 by the First National Uranium Mines Ltd. and Groundstar Resources Limited. The HK-10 and 11 are overstaked by the Bon Group. Soil samples were taken on the property.
