DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is underlain by limestone and volcanic rocks of Upper Triassic age.

Principal mineralization occurs in a shear zone which extends for several hundred feet and is 3 to 4 feet wide. Chalcopyrite and bornite occur in quartz veinlets and as disseminations in the shear zone in the volcanics.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the west side of Adam River, 1 mile southwest of Keta Lake at 1,800 to 2,500 feet elevation.

The "M" and "Tammy" groups consist of 47 claims, the M 1 to 37 and Tammy 1 to 10. The "M" Group was staked in 1969 by Bethlehem Copper Corporation Ltd. and transferred to Western Standard Silver Mines Ltd. The Tammy group was staked by Western Standard.

From 1969 to 1973 work done on the property included surface geological, mapping, a geochemical soil survey, and two holes totalling 540 feet drilled on the M 28 and 30 claims.

The M and Tammy Groups were associated with the Boyes group. (See 92 L/8, CU 1).

Associated minerals or products of value - Silver.
