DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is underlain by Karmutsen fine-grained massive and amygdaloidal basalt of Upper Triassic age. Chalcopyrite and bornite are disseminated in the basalt.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between 600 and 1,500 feet elevation on the southwest side of Adam River, near Rooney Lake.

In 1969 the Rooney 1 to 28 claims were owned by Newconex Canadian Exploration Ltd. A geochemical survey over Rooney 1 to 8 claims included collecting 16 rock-chip samples and 500 soil and silt samples.

In 1970 Armeda Copper Mines, Ltd., acquired the property as the CV and Plus group totalling 100 claims. The Company carried out magnetometer and geochemical soil surveys.

In 1972 Sayward Explorations Ltd. held the Rooney group of 88 claims, which included the Cathy 1 to 40; Billy 1 to 36, Berna 1 to 4, and Moon 1 to 8. Work done on the property included surface geological mapping at 1 inch equals 400 feet, and a magnetic survey of 3.25 line miles covering Billy 6, 21, Berna 3, 4 and Cathy 30 to 39.
