DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

These showings consist of magnesite veins in altered Shulaps volcanics in the Yalakom fault zone. There are several veins, 2 to 12 feet in width distributed over a distance of 3,000 feet, most of them having an average strike of north 50° west and a nearly vertical dip. Nine samples assayed from 32 to 42.8% MgO.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located on a steep ridge lying north-east of Blue Creek, between Blue Creek and Yalakom River. In 1946, Mr. L. Hansen, owned the Sunny Nos. 1 to 4 claims, known as the Sunny or Sunny Jim Group.
