DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The Tim claims are underlain by an indicated moderately to steeply northeast-dipping sequence of Nicola volcanic rocks which is locally intruded by syenodiorite intrusive (?) breccia bodies and by northeast or northwest-trending syenodiorite dykes. Copper mineralization occurs as disseminations and in vein and fracture stockworks spatially related to shear zones and syenodiorite dykes. (G.E.M., 1972, p. 325).

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

The property is located some 65 km east-southeast of Williams Lake and 21 km northeast of Lac La Hache.

Coranex Limited was incorporated in January 1965 to carry out exploration for a partnership comprised of Frobex Limited, Canadian Nickel Company Limited, Denison Mines Limited, Dome Exploration (Canada) Limited and McIntyre Porcupine Mines Limited. Each company held a 20% interest and Frobex was manager.

Several showings were discovered in 1966 through a reconnaissance geochemical survey and some 450 claims were staked in the Tim and other groups. Exploration work over these claims in the 1966-68 period included geological mapping, geochemical, magnetometer and induced potential surveys and 1,500' of diamond drilling in 5 holes.

The showing at this location was held in 1972 by Amax Exploration, Inc as the Tim 69-74 and 76 claims. Work by the company included geological mapping and airborne magnetometer surveys.

Stallion Resources Ltd, incorporated February 1980, acquired the Tim group of claims (48 units). Induced potential and geochemical surveys and trenching located three showings. A 1,000' first phase drilling program on No. 1 showing in 1983 gave drill indicated reserves of 82,850 tons grading 2.14% copper and 0.35 oz/t silver (George Cross News Letter, 6/12/83).
