DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area of the original claim block underlain by intrusives in the form of small stocks ranging in composition from syenites to peridotites. Trenching showed the mineralization to be in a shear zone about 70 feet wide and trending southwesterly within a narrow band or prong of ultrabasic rock. Disseminated chalcocyanite and pyrite is associated with the magnetite. Preliminary chip samples in trenches gave an average of about 0.22% copper over 71 feet width and a strike length of about 100 ft.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Located in area of Fishtrap Creek about 8 miles by roads west of Barriere.

Cambridge Mines, Limited staked the C.P. group of 32 claims in March 1970 after obtaining some evidence of copper mineralization in random geochemical drainage sampling. Reconnaissance geological and geochemical soil sampling located copper mineralization near the southwest corner of the claim block. A further group of 10 claims was staked in September 1970. Fourteen of the claims have been retained.
