Map 3-1966 indicates the area is underlain in part by Permian Cache Creek group volcanic and sedimentary rocks. "In a highly serpentized belt of dunite rock skirting the river-banks numerous nodules of high-grade float as well as narrow segregations of speckled chromite in place have been found" (RMM, 1932, p. 154).
