DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

An outcrop of calcareous quartz rock contains the green, nickeliferous silicate, garnierite. The rock is foliated and the green mineral lies in parallel bands through it. The outcrop is 25' by 10' in extent and may be an immense boulder. Samples taken at intervals across the 25' outcrop assayed 0.11% nickel and 0.17% chromium oxide Cr₂O₃.
