DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Several quartz veins, 2 to 3 feet wide and slightly mineralized with galena, zinc-blende and pyrite, occur in silicified quartz-schist country rock. The veins strike N10°E and dip steeply east. A sample assayed 0.02 ounces of gold; 24 ounces of silver per ton; 42% lead and 6% zinc.

A prominent outcrop of mariposite is also present.
