DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Pyrite, chalcopyrite and gold occur along shear zones, slips and joint planes in Jurassic andesitic agglomerates, breccias and tuffs.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 6 miles ESE of Likely.

The Joy 1 to 6 and Jock 3 to 8 claims were purchased from S. Miecznik, in 1969, by Leemac Mines Ltd. Additional staking was done in the Rip 1 to 21, Jock 1, 2 and 9 to 17, Mesky 1 to 6, and Eric 1 to 6, for a total of 56 claims, under the name Cedar Creek group.

In 1971, geological, geochemical, I.P. and magnetometer surveys were carried out. During 1972, minor diamond drilling was done.

In late 1973, the group was reduced to the Joy 1 to 6 and Jock 3 to 8, a total of 12 claims. One diamond drill hole was put down 250 feet during the year.

Leemac Mines still held the Joy and Jock claims in 1974.
