Minor gold is found in quartz veins situated within Mesozoic, green-grey, andesitic porphyry. The andesite is oxidized and shows hydrothermal alteration.

The property is located on Lukin Creek, at the south end of Paquette Lake, 2 miles NE of Likely.

In 1933, the claims were owned by H. Lukin and A. Campbell. A tunnel was driven along one of the quartz veins.

Continental McKinney Mines Limited optioned the property from S. Miecznik in 1967. They carried out geological mapping, 500 feet of trenching and 5,000 square feet of stripping.
