DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Three chalcopyrite showings occur in dolomitic limestone along the limestone-andesite complex boundary.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the north bank of Quesnel River, on Slide Mountain at elevation 2,800 feet.

Nippon Mining of Canada Ltd. owned the 408 Slide and River claims, in 1970. Geological mapping, 19.5 line-miles of I.P. and magnetometer surveys and a geochemical survey on 2,150 soil samples were carried out during the year.

In 1971, the group was reduced to 71 claims. Mapping, trenching and collection of 1,070 soil samples was carried out by Nippon.
