DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The occurrence consists of quartz veins in andesitic volcanics in a zone of shearing trending N63°W. The main exposure is a large vein which widens at depth and shows free gold, small amounts of chalcopyrite and pyrite, and abundant sericite.

A sample assayed 0.30 ounces of gold per ton.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located just south of McKee Lake, between Elbow and Crooked Lakes.

The property was owned by J. Rowley, in 1934, but the discovery was made by G. Hoehne and C. Goetjen. The Gold Coin Syndicate acquired it the same year. Gold Coin dug pits and sunk a 50 foot shaft.
