Chalcopyrite and malachite occur in shears and fractures in a dark green trachyte porphyry, containing abundant euhedral feldspar phenocrysts, of Jurassic age. HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located $l_{\overline{z}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ miles WNW of Miocene and 15 miles NE of 150 Mile House at elevation 3,500 feet.

Grandeur Mines Ltd. owned the Wiggins Creek 1 to 18, Lucky Dawn 1 to 4, Hearts Content 1 and 2, Sandra 1 to 3, Mabel 1, and Nancy 1 and 2 claims, which made up the property in 1969. During the year, they carried out 21 line-miles of geochemical survey.

In 1970, Grandeur carried out geological mapping, 30 line-miles of magnetometer survey, trenching and a geochemical survey of 400 soil samples.

In 1971, Grandeur changed its name to China Commercial Corporation Ltd. The claims were transferred to Wiggins Creek Copper Mines Ltd. which was incorporated in June 1971; China Commercial held a 73 per cent interest in the new company.
