DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Pyrrhotite, pyrite and chalcopyrite occur mainly in fracture fillings present in Middle Jurassic volcanic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located S of Quesnel Lake and N of Hen Ingram Lake.

In 1965, Helican Explorations Limited owned the KE group, and held the LO group by an option agreement for a total of 212 claims. Geological mapping, a geophysical survey, trenching and stripping were done. Five BXW holes were diamond drilled a total of 1,500 feet and 2, 4½ inch diameter diamond drill holes were put down 306 feet.

The group was transferred to Pegasus Explorations Limited when work was terminated.
