DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The area of the showings is a moderately depressed syncline of purplish pyroxene andesite flows and pyroclastics overlying limestone of late Triassic or Early Jurassic age. Minor malachite stain is present but the chief interest was in narrow veinlets of calcite with silver-rich tetrahedrite.

Associated minerals or products of value - Copper.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Gerimi Creek, 15 miles SE of Quesnel on a ridge between Quesnel and Swift Rivers.

The property consists of the B.I. 1 to 36 claims. In 1965, Coast Silver Mines Ltd. acquired the claims and carried out line-cutting, stripping, a geomagnetic survey and 200 feet of diamond drilling of EX core.

By 1967, Coast Silver had drilled 1,695 feet in 4 holes, done stripping, a soil survey and a geomagnetic survey.
