Chalcopyrite, with minor bornite and molybdenite, occurs in a quartz-feldspar-biotite porphyry which intrudes Upper Triassic /Lower Jurassic volcanics.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 6 miles E of Quesnel, on the N side of the Quesnel River, at elevation 1,600 feet.

The Kate, Ruth, Kopper Nob, M & S, QR, Rich and Daphne claims were owned by Canyon Creek Holdings Ltd. and operated by Noranda Exploration Company, Limited, in 1973.
