HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the east side of Quesnel River, at the head of Cantin Creek, 15 miles SE by road from Quesnel.

Coast Silver Mines Ltd. acquired the claims in 1967. During the year, a geological survey, magnetometer and electromagnetic survey, soil sampling, 720 feet of trenching, and 2,360 feet of diamond drilling in 6 holes was reported. The claims were subsequently allowed to lapse.
