HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at about the 2,800 foot elevation on the south side of Williams Lake, some 4 miles southeast of the town of Williams Lake.

The showings were staked as the Ni group of 8 claims by Frank Merryth in April 1956. The Granby Consolidated Mining, Smelting and Power Company, Limited, optioned the property later in the year and put down 3 short diamond drill holes.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A zone of brecciation as much as 400 feet wide and trending about west is almost completely replaced by ankeritic carbonate. The zone is crossed by narrow veinlets of chalcedonic quartz and in some areas contain small flakes of pale-green mariposite. Minute grains of millerite have been identified. A sample of selected material assayed: nickel, 0.23%; chromium, 0.27%.
