HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This occurrence is located between elevations of 2,075 and 2,375 feet on the north side of the highway about 4 miles east of the town of Williams Lake.

A group of 12 claims, owned by A.W. Haddock & associates, of Williams Lake, were reported under option to J.O. Williams in 1935. Some work was done in open cutting.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A fracture zone striking northeasterly and dipping north-west occurs at the contact of serpentine with underlying limestone. The zone, probably largely confined to the limestone, contains ankerite, calcite, pyrite, and mariposite. The mineralization is chiefly a replacement in the limestone. A sample across 3 feet in the fracture zone assayed: gold, trace; silver, trace; nickel, 0.15%. The footwall rock, near the lowest showing, contains numerous large quartz gash-veins which are very sparsely mineralized, one showing a little chalcopyrite. Samples of the serpentine taken some distance from the mineralized zone contained higher nickel values than are present in the zone itself; a sample taken 50 feet from the zone assayed 0.23% nickel.
