DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The occurrence has been categorized as a porphyry copper with quartz diorite wall rock. Three pyrite and chalcopyrite mineralized zones are indicated.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is centred approximately 7 miles ENE of Marguerite Post Office, at elevation 3,600 feet.

In 1968, Morocco Mines Ltd. carried out a geochemical survey on the claims. In 1969, Morocco reported a geo-physical survey done. During 1969, Morocco transferred the claims to McLeese Lake Copper Mines Ltd. The operator of the claims was Canex Aerial Exploration Ltd.

In 1970, work reported was 88.4 line-miles of I.P. survey and 3,912 feet of diamond drilling in 11 holes.
