DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The mineralization on the property consists of arsenopyrite in sheared granodiorite, chalcopyrite in quartz stringers and chalcopyrite and molybdenite disseminated in the granodiorite. The granodiorite intrudes volcanic rock and small sections of limestone. The shear zone strikes S75°E, dips SW and has a width of 25 feet. The heaviest concentration of mineralization is within the shear zone.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
The property is centered ½ mile SW of Indian Reserve 12, at the N end of Cuisson Lake, at elevation 3,000 feet.

The property was owned by H.F., H.B. and J.F. Hill, in 1928. Work carried out was the digging of a trench and an open-cut 75 feet long.

Geophysical surveys were carried out in 1959 by Canex Aerial Exploration Ltd., in 1967 by A. Lenec, et al., and in 1968 by Coast Silver Mines Ltd.

In 1970, Imperial Oil Enterprises Ltd. owned the property consisting of claims G 1 to 10 and H 11 to 16. Work completed during the year were 11 line-miles of I.P. survey, 14 linemiles of magnetometer survey and 4 diamond drill holes totalling 2,023 feet.
