DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Chalcopyrite and molybdenite mineralization occur in Permian Cache Creek volcanics and in Guichon Creek batholithic intrusives.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the SE slope of Granite Mountain, 5 miles SW of Skeleton Lake at elevation 4,500 feet.

In 1970, Tanguard Explorations Ltd. acquired the GR 1 to 20 claims. During 1971, the company carried out a geo-chemical survey, 300 feet of trenching and a diamond drilling program of 5 holes totalling 1,500 feet.

In 1972, Vanguard changed its name to Newvan Resources Ltd. In 1973, the company acquired the TGV 9, 10, 19 to 26, 35 to 49 and 50 to 52 claims. Fourteen percussion drill holes totalling 2,500 feet and 200 feet of trenching were completed on the GR claims during that year. Also, in 1973, 25.6 line-miles of induced polarization survey and 12 percussion drill holes totalling 3,000 feet were done on the TGV claims.
