DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The occurrence is underlain by Jurassic gneissic granodiorite of the Coast Intrusions. The mineralization occurs as weakly disseminated chalcopyrite, with bornite, in the granodiorite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The occurrence is located 6 miles W of Charlotte Lake, S of Atnarko River, straddling the Skeena-Cariboo Mining Division boundary.

In 1969, American Smelting and Refining Company owned Ada claims 1 to 44. A geological survey was done. Twenty-five stream silt samples were collected for geochemical analysis.
