DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The mineralization consists of chalcopyrite and minor molybdenite with quartz lenses in a sheared belt of green schist, apparently a sheared phase of the surrounding batholith rock. The shear zone strikes N20°E and dips at a small angle to the south. A few tons of mineralized rock, taken from the smooth wall, were piled on the dump. There appears to be no continuity to the sulphide mineralization.

Associated minerals or products of value - Molybdenum.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The claims are located on the east side of Dean Channel, midway between Kimsquit and Labouchere Channel.

The claims were acquired by B.T. Jacobson, T. Oleon and A.J. Enjuich in 1928.

The work completed was one large open cut, one 20 foot adit and two or three smaller cuts.
