DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Pyrite, chalcopyrite, and molybdenite occur in quartz veins and fractures in hornfelsed Hazelton volcanics and in quartz diorite and quartz monzonite intrusions.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the west side of Ramsey Creek, at an elevation of 4,000 to 4,800 feet, some 45 miles north-northeast of Bella Coola. The claims lie within Tweedsmuir Provincial Park.

The Boom 1-118 and Wilf 1-18 claims were held in 1968 by Kerr Addison Mines Limited. Work included geological mapping, a magnetometer survey over 180,000 feet of line, geochemical soil sampling over an area 4,800 by 8,000 feet, and diamond drilling in 6 holes totalling 4,081 feet. In 1969 an induced polarization survey was carried out over 8.8 linemiles.

In 1970, 3 holes totalling 544 feet were diamond drilled. The claims were cancelled prior to 1974.
